

## **REQUEST FOR QUOTATION**

### **Removal of Sunken Vessel from Bellefield Landing Turning Basin (Phase 2)**

#### **A. BACKGROUND**

The Ports Authority of the Turks and Caicos (PATCI) is a government statutory body which is responsible for the safe and secure management of the ports in the Turks and Caicos. South Dock, Provo is the main port under management of the Ports Authority. Bellefield Landing is the government seaport for North Caicos and Middle Caicos. A Welcome Center opened at Bellefield Landing in October 2022. Several sub-projects are being undertaken to improve the operations of the Bellefield Landing. The dredging of the Bellefield Landing Channel is ongoing. Boats slips are in the process of being installed to improve safety of passenger who travel to the port on local ferried. Several inter-islands and international shippers plan to commence direct voyages to Bellefield Landing following dredging of the channel. However, access to the commercial dock is limited due to the presence of a sunken vessel in the turning basin.

#### **REQUEST FOR QUOTATIONS**

The PATCI is requesting quotations from service providers (firms or individual) with relevant business-license and experience to remove the sunken vessel from the turning basin. Photos of the sunken vessel at the turning basin are attached.

The detailed services being requested include:

- 1. Removal of sunken vessel from the turning basin by mechanical excavation and transportation of the excavated vessel to the public dumpsite.**

**At the end of the engagement the sunken vessel in its entirety should be removed from seabed in the turning basin in manner which removes all danger to operating ferry and cargo vessels.**



## B. RESPONDING TO THE RFQ

### The required services are needed immediately

It is advised that interested service providers should make arrangements to visit Bellefield Landing to inspect the project area to get a better understanding of the project.

In responding to this RFQ, interested service providers should submit the following as part of their response:

- Copy of valid business license in relevant category
- Proposed work program demonstrating that you understand the scope of require services. This should show equipment to be deployed (including environment protection) and personnel required to carry out the scope of services. The time to completed the work should be clearly stated.
- Provide the detailed costing to provide services and payment terms.
- Bidders Quotation should be valid for a period of **not** less than **90** calendar days

Kindly provide and any other information to considered relevant.

### Evaluation Criteria

Responses to the RFQ would be evaluated based on the following criteria:

Work Program	- 40 Points
Fee Proposal	- 40 points
Time to Complete	- 20 points

The selected service will be given a Work Order under the FIDIC Consultancy White Book.
