



REQUEST FOR QUOTATION

Perimeter Fence Repair at South Dock Providenciales

Summary

The Ports Authority of the Turks and Caicos is a government statutory body, which is responsible for the safe and secure management of the ports in the Turks and Caicos Islands. Safety and security within the ports system is managed in compliance with the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code [ISPS Code] and a related Port Facility Security Plan. Training and drills for personnel is mandatory to reduce liability and cultivate a safety and security culture.

Scope of Services

The Ports Authority of the Turks & Caicos Islands is requesting quotations (RFQ) for the Repairing of Damaged Perimeter Fencing at the Port in South Dock Providenciales.

The contractor will be responsible for the removal and disposal the damaged perimeter fencing (Approximately 130ft). All of the damaged material is to be disposed at the public dumpsite. The contractor will be required to wear all protective gear while removing and transporting damaged fencing from site.

The contractor will supply all tools and Equipment/Material (8ft Chain-link Fence, Poles, Barb Wire, Fence Clamps, Concrete) to perform and complete these works. The Contractor is required to excavate holes for new fence poles to the required depth and width. Install new fence poles in the prepared footings and secure them properly. Attach coated fencing to the poles using appropriate clamps and hardware. Install barb wire at specified heights and tensions. Ensure proper alignment and tension of the fence. It is expected that the contractor would visit the project site prior to bidding to review the proposed works and determine the most efficient method for completion.

The contractor will adhere to all security and safety arrangements mandated by the Ports Authority during the works.

The contractor will carefully coordinate project work plans with the Ports Security and other port users to lessen disruption of Port daily operations.

In submitting their quotation prospective bidders must provide:

- A copy of valid business license
- An Overall Project Cost to complete the works (all cost must include equipment, labor and profit)
- A Program of works schedule outlining duration of the works to be completed

Prospective bidders should contact the Project Manager to confirm vessel location for the proposed project area or to obtain information to support their quotations. **Bidders will be scored based on Methodology, Project Cost, Time for completion.**
